  - (ii) The UK Government unilaterally purports to exercise jurisdiction (which is not recognised by the Government of Mauritius) over the Chagos Archipelago and its waters.

- 3. The issue of this licence does not relieve the vessel from the obligation to comply with any other enactment in force in Mauritius.
