In a preliminary discussion, we comment on the progress being made in the SIOTI FIP and how its revised action plan can be also supportive with our audits and certification process.

1. 1. Status of the 10 conditions.

The purchase is confirmed and the tags already underway. The expected delivery time is August. The tagging expert will be Iñigo Onaindia and a meeting will be programmed with him (possibly coinciding with the team's in-person meeting at the end of July), to explain the references and other details of the tagging process, which will be in accordance to the procedures already in place. We propose October as a suitable month for the tagging team to be able to travel to Seychelles and join the first available vessel from Echebatar.

- New To for the above ampliation. Ian will make an analysis so that we can propose it for quotation.
